- Review and sign off for Harassment and Abuse Policy (signed copy to remain on file)

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The Coaches Statement of Values

Integrity:

The coach must act with integrity in performing all duties owed to athletes, the sport, other members of the coaching profession, and the public.

Competence:

The coach strives to be well prepared and current in order that all duties in the respective discipline are fulfilled with competence.

Athlete's Interest:

The coach must act in the best interest of the athlete's development as a whole person.

Respect for the Rules:

The coach must accept both the letter and the spirit of the rules that define and govern sport.

Respect for Officials:

The coach must accept the role of officials in providing judgement to ensure that competitions are conducted fairly and according to the established rules.

Responsibility to other Coaches:

The coaches' conduct toward other coaches must be characterized by courtesy, good faith, and respect.

Personal Conduct:

The coach must maintain the highest standards of personal integrity when dealing with players, parents, officials. They must ensure they, along with those within their charge, represent our organization with dignity and class at all times,

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Harassment and Abuse Policy

Brantford CYO Girls Basketball Inc. is committed to provide all players, coaches, convenors, and anyone associated with the basketball program a safe environment for the opportunity to develop basketball and life skills. Brantford CYO Girls Basketball Inc. has a zero tolerance policy for sexual abuse, harassment, molestation, corporal punishment and neglect.

When coaches or volunteers are dealing with players we will adopt the "two adult rule". Adopting the "two adult rule" protects not only the player, but the coach or volunteer as well.

Any coach, convenor, CYO Executive, or volunteer will be required to go through a screen process before they begin working with the girls. The following is a list of screening procedures required:

- Signed volunteer application
- Criminal record check
- Background reference check (minimum 2)

Personal interview (if requested)

If a player or volunteer experiences such harassment or abuse, the player or volunteer should promptly and accurately report such behaviour to his or her coach or to one of the members of the CYO Executive Committee. The problem will be immediately investigated and appropriate action will be taken.

As part of the prevention plan for abuse and harassment the CYO Executive Committee will respond to incidents of alleged abuse or harassment by assuring the serious and compassionate response to the allegations; completing a written report; fulfilling statutory reporting obligations to child protective agencies or police authorities; will not make legal statement without the aid of legal counsel; maintain confidentiality of the victim and perpetrator; immediately suspend the alleged perpetrator pending the outcome of the investigation and report the incident to the Brantford CYO Girls Basketball Inc. insurance provider.
